Your church council has decided to suspend all in-person worship services and church activities through Thursday, April 2, 2020. Your council will have another emergency meeting that evening to re-evaluate the current health crisis and we will communicate all decisions with you.

The church office will continue to remain open for the purposes of staff work and the recording of worship services, etc. For the safety and health of staff and myself, please do not come to the church in person for any reason. If you need something, please contact the church office or myself by phone, email or text.

I will continue to record Sunday services and the Lenten services as well as other recordings as I see necessary. You will receive a One Call Now when the services are up and ready to view. There will also be bulletins on the website so you can follow along and participate.

It is important we continue to look out for one another. If you yourself need something or you know of someone who needs something, please call the church or myself. If there is a person on your mind you are concerned about, call them directly and ask how they are doing and if they have any needs. Together we can take care of our congregation.

These are challenging times in the Church, in our communities and in the world. However, our purpose continues. To change the world one person at a time by sharing the love and power of Jesus Christ with family members, friends and neighbors.
